Registration: \$200 payable, to SkiSIG, send to Connie Varner, 203 Persimmon Place, Apex, NC 27523. Due November 1, 2009.

Final payment: \$625 (no lift ticket), \$898 (four-day lift ticket), or \$829.75 (three-day lift ticket) payable to SkiSIG, send to Connie Varner, 203 Persimmon Place, Apex, NC 27523. Due January 19, 2010.

Lift tickets: Can be purchased through us (note prices above) or directly from Steamboat Central Reservations at (800) 922- 2722 (reference Reservation #EL4QRT).

Lodging: Pricing assumes two people to a room. Roommate matching (same gender) is available. Single supplement is the cost of half a room (\$735). Non-M friends and family are welcome.

If you wish to arrive a day early or stay a day late, work it out with Steamboat Central Reservations. You will probably have to stay in a different property, and there is no guarantee of Hospitality or roommate matching for extra days.

These townhomes are ski-i/ski-out, plus there is a shuttle for trips to town, or if you wish to start your ski day at the Gondola Base. They include all of the expected amenities: full kitchen, high-speed wireless, cable TV, DVD player, washer-dryer, hot tubs, indoor pools, fitness center, etc.

What's Not Included:

- Transportation to/from Steamboat Springs (airfare can be booked through Steamboat Central Reservations – the local airport is Haydn, airport code HDN)
- Shuttle to/from the airport (can be arranged with Steamboat Central Reservations)
- Any other lift ticket options, equipment rental or lessons, although these can all be arranged through Steamboat Central Reservations at discounted rates, due to our package
- Lunch, dinner all days
